

Dear OPC Pool Guests,

We are excited to be opening the OPC Lap and Therapy pools. The pool staff are facilitating a soft opening of the pool facility with a limit of 4 people in the pool area at any one time. Lap lanes will be limited to two people and the therapy pool the same. We will be adjusting the schedule based on usage and safety parameters. Due to safety and health guidelines, pool visitors will be expected to follow the guidelines below when using the pool facilities:

1. **PLEASE STAY HOME if you have a fever, are feeling ill, or have come in contact within the last 14 days of anyone who has had COVID-19.**
2. A **mask must be worn** when entering the facility, in the locker room and on the pool deck but not in the water or while showering.
3. Please **social distance** when in the locker room, on the pool deck and in the pool, leaving 6 ft. between yourself and others.
4. Please **reduce the time you use the locker room**. We recommend arriving in your swim attire under clothes or a bathrobe.
5. Please **take a shower before entering the pool**. If you need to take a shower after using the pool, please do so quickly to limit the time you are in the locker room.
6. **Hair dryers will not be provided** in the locker rooms. If you must use a hair dryer, bring your own equipment and wear a mask while drying your hair at all times.
7. **If using a locker, leave the locker door OPEN WHEN DONE** so that it can be properly sanitized by staff.
8. **We are not providing any equipment for in the pool (noodles, belts, dumbbells, etc.)** you must bring your own.
9. A cashier will be at the lower level to accept your pool payment of \$3 or \$50 for an Open Swim Punch card (17 punches). Previously purchased punch cards will be accepted.
10. Park on the lower level and enter through the aquatic entrance for the health screening.
11. The staff will be following all [CDC](https://www.cdc.gov) and Michigan Department of Health guidelines.
